

## About *Proprium Journal of Psychology*

The aim of *Proprium Journal of Psychology* is to bring quality academic work to the general public. As such, *Proprium* will accept articles for review that are well-written and make appropriate use of the existing literature. Thus, when students and scholars have exceptional ideas they desire publishing, this is an excellent outlet. However, to assure *Proprium* only publishes quality work, we require articles are written in APA style, and reference peer-reviewed material, or material from reputable sources, such as the CDC or other governmental institutions. Acceptable topics for consideration include topics relevant to developmental and clinical psychology, behavioral medicine, and sport psychology. However, other topics in psychology will also be considered.

## Submission guidelines

Articles acceptable for publication in *Proprium Journal of Psychology* are literature reviews, essays, position papers, and editorials. Articles accepted for review can be no longer than 20 pages, from cover to references, including figures and tables.

## Peer review process

To provide readers with the best possible quality, journals submitted to *Proprium* undergo a peer review process, blindly reviewed by a minimum of two peers. *Proprium* does not restrict peer comments, thus as all scholars understand, reviews at times can seem harsh. However, *Proprium* will not tolerate any unfairness or disrespectful review comments.

## Publication schedule

*Proprium Journal of Psychology* publishes articles online on a continuing basis, however for referencing purposes, there are two issues published per volume. Articles published in the months of January to June of each year will appear on the first issue, whereas articles published from July through December will appear in the second issue.
